Rhythm 6/8 - each step 3 beats except where noted. Arms V. Circle or open circle/line.

 $\cap$  point L  $\uparrow$  (not flat-footed, just toes on ground, quite a pronounced point, with a little lift afterwards),  $\cap \rightarrow$  Lxb q (2 beats), sR q (1 beat), Lxf, sR; ( $\cap \leftarrow$  sway L,  $\cap \rightarrow$  sway R) x 2. Step 4 tends to turn in to another small sway, this may not matter but do not let it get too pronounced. During the slight pauses at the end of each section of the music, just hold the last sway and wait to start again.

Translation of lyrics by Nolwenn Monjarret; What noise on earth? who is singing for me and who I am hearing? How much I like these voices who sing in the skies, and what do they say in their song? What is new that happened on earth?

We hear the people sing on earth; I come to tell you that in the sky there is something beyond compare a small child blessed, king of Jerusalem and who was born for them (the people) in the town of Bethlehem.
