- 1. $\supset \rightarrow$ R; L; R slip-step (i.e. R (2 beats), L (1 beat); R;); \cap ↑ rock in L; \cap ↓ rock back R; \cap ← sway left; \cap → sway right; mirror.
- 2. $\supset \rightarrow$ 2 slip-steps starting R (i.e. R (2 beats), L (1 beat); R; L (2 beats), R (1 beat); L;); travelling turn clockwise in 2 steps R; L; $\cap \rightarrow$ sway right; $\cap \leftarrow$ sway left. x 2
