Preferably short lines, close-hold; otherwise open circle, arms V. Rhythm 6/8; slow steps 2 beats, quick steps 1 beat. Dance fits musical phrases. Start at the beginning of any musical phrase on the heavy drumbeat. All the larger slow steps in or out move diagonally to the right. Dance can be done to left or right. Hypnotic, flowing.

 \cap diag. back to right R s, small step slightly back diag. to right L q, in place R q, diag. fwd to right L s; diag. fwd. to right R s, small step slightly fwd. diag. to right L q, in place R q, diag. back to right L s.
