Formation; open circle. Rhythm 4/4. Steps are 2 beats (s =slow) or 1 beat (q = quick). The dance crosses the music. It is similar to Sta Dhio or Pogonishte but with two extra slow steps in the middle.

Measure 1; Arms W or possibly close-hold (forearm over forearm, similar to Hanter Dro) $\cap \rightarrow$ sR s, Lxb q, sR q;

Measure 2; $\cap \uparrow L s$, $\cap \downarrow R s$,

Measure 3; $\cap \rightarrow$ Lxf s not crossing much, sR s, Lxf s.
