Chor.; Paul Boizot, 1994 approx. Music; No One's Slave, by World Without Walls (written by Theo Simon), from "The Mamas Warning. This song has also been covered by Kangaroo Moon, but I have not tried the dance to their version.

A dance with lots of turns and points....

Rhythm 4/4. Start with the singing. Arms; V

- 1. Simpler version of dance, for less experienced groups, or to introduce the dance initially, or just to make it more accessible this is what I would teach now, only moving on to the original version if the group was able and enthusiastic! Only steps 5 to 12 differ between the two versions. Dancers who have difficulty with turns can of course walk instead of turn in steps 13 to 20 those turns do come with a health warning!
- $\supset \to L$, R, L, \cap point R; $\cap \downarrow R$, $\cap \uparrow L$, R, L; point R \uparrow , $\cap \downarrow$ step R, L, R; point L \uparrow , repl. L, travelling turn anti-clockwise in 2 steps; keeping hands unjoined point R $\cap \uparrow$, repl. R, travelling turn clockwise in 2 steps; join hands & point L $\cap \uparrow$ repl. L, point R \uparrow repl. R.
- 2. Full original choreography;
- $\supset \to$ L, R, L, \cap point R; $\cap \downarrow$ R, $\cap \uparrow$ L, swivel 180° anti-clockwise on L & step $\cup \uparrow$ R, L; point R $\cup \downarrow$, repl. R, step \downarrow L & swivel 180° clockwise, $\cap \downarrow$ R; point L \uparrow repl. L, travelling turn anti-clockwise in 2 steps; keeping hands unjoined point R $\cap \uparrow$, repl. R, travelling turn clockwise in 2 steps; join hands & point L $\cap \uparrow$ repl. L, point R \uparrow , repl. R.

All points except the first 2 are slightly diag. away from body in both versions.
